Infact, it can be materialized with dispensing room to curtail your initial expenses.

compartmentalized in the consulting room or as a separate room. The medicines should be kept in segments to accommodate dilutions, Mother Tinctures, and Biochemics. It is always better to keep the medicines in alphabetic order and in suitable cupboards, utensils for storing sugar of milk, labels, butter paper etc. The basic requirement in this section is of wooden or metal racks to store medicines. The racks need to be specially designed, particularly step-design to use the maximum available space as there are very large number of homoeopathy medicines. There should be separate closed racks for storing extra stocks and some odorous medicines and mother tinctures.
