There was a persistent demand by the homoeopathic doctors that the Registrar of Karnataka Board for Homoeopathic System of Medicine must be a qualified homoeopath. Serious attempts made by the homoeopaths and blocked the appointment of an officer from the Dept. of Indian System of Medicine and Homoeopathy as the Registrar. Finally government is appointing only a qualified homoeopath from the state government service. Dr. Ramdass, Dr. N. Ramesh, Dr. Mohd. Aftab Waseem and Dr. Munir Ahmed R. have served as Registrar of the Board. Now Dr. Aswathnarayana is officiating as Registrar.

social organizations and executive member of Central council of Homoeopathy.
